What Can You See at the Exhibition?

- Artistic objects made from reclaimed materials creative projects crafted from plastic, glass, paper, and textiles, demonstrating how seemingly useless items can inspire artistic expression.
- Eco-posters promoting recycling, responsible consumption, and resource conservation.
- Interactive installations highlighting the problem of overproduction of waste and the potential for reuse.
